- 5. What is the fourth apparition that the witches do not want to show Macbeth and what does it ultimately show Macbeth? How does this put a damper on his former feelings of security?
- 6. What does Macbeth mean when he says of himself: "From this moment/The very firstlings of my heart shall be/The firstlings of my hand."? How has he changed since the beginning of the play? (Scene 1)
- 7. What is Macbeth's plan for punishing Macduff's disloyalty? What would be the motive for his plan? (Scene 1)
- 8. How does Lady Macduff feel about her husband leaving his wife and children to go to England? Why does she think he has "fled" to England? (Scene 2)
- 9. What is the first reason Malcolm gives Macduff for why he wouldn't be a good king?
- 10. What is the second reason Malcolm gives for why he wouldn't be a good king?
- 11. Why is Malcolm giving all of these reasons for not being a good king to Macduff? For what purpose?
- 12. What does Malcolm urge Macduff turn his grief over the loss of his family into?
